ABOUT THE TODD A. MCGEE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This memorial scholarship was established by friends of Todd in honor of his work as a computer skills teacher in Lumberton, North Carolina for five years as well as a health and physical education teacher at the River Valley School District for 22 years upon return to Pennsylvania. During his education career, Todd served as the River Valley speed and agility coach as well as other JV and Varsity coaching positions. He was a PIAA referee for regional basketball and volleyball games. Over his lifetime, Todd was very involved in sports as a player and coach of many regional youth teams including elementary basketball and Little League Baseball.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

One \$2000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating River Valley School District senior who participated in one or more athletic activities while in high school and intends on furthering his/her education as a full-time student at either a two or four-year college or university. The selection committee will place emphasis on students who pursue collegiate athletics.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all complete applications based on the applicant's sustained record of academic excellence, achievements in varsity athletics, as well as other extracurricular and community activities.

NOTIFICATION AND RECEIPT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will be notified by early May via e-mail and a confirmation letter. The letter will inform the recipient of what needs to be provided to the River Valley Education Foundation to receive the scholarship. Information relating to a required thank you letter will be included with the confirmation letter from the Education Foundation.

2. As a separate document, prepare an up-to-date personal resume that includes your academic achievements, senior-year courses, extracurricular activities, community service, etc.
3. Place three copies of your application materials (including your resume) in an unsealed 9 x 12 brown envelope. If needed you can get the envelope from the Guidance Office.
4. Write your name and the scholarship name on the outside of the envelope.
5. Submit all materials to your guidance counselor as soon as possible but not later than April 28
6. Request that your counselor provide River Valley Education Foundation with your RVHS academic transcript.
